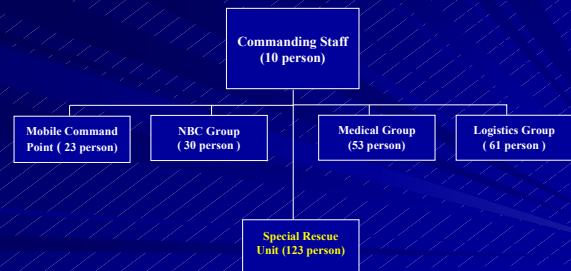
Time for Readiness:
